Events with themes related to sexuality are appearing frequently in schools across the nation, often organized by GSAs (Gender and Sexuality Alliances). Are any of these occasions scheduled in your local district? Discover the details. Stand against the inappropriate exposure of children to sexual content within educational settings.

SEPTEMBER

SEPT 16 - 23

BISEXUAL

AWARENESS WEEK

Celebrates people who are sexually attracted to males and females.
Culminates with Bisexuality Day (Sept. 23rd).

OCTOBER

ALL MONTH

LGBTQ HISTORY MONTH

Celebrates LGBTQ individuals as 'heroes' and falsely asserts historical figures like George Washington Carver and others were gay.

OCT 1 - 7

BANNED BOOKS WEEK

Celebrates 'freedom to read' and promotes obscene books to teens containing substance use, incest, rape, gender confusion, graphic sex, etc.

OCT 11

COMING OUT DAY

Encourages children to 'come out' as LGBTQ in school on this day.

OCT 18

INTERNATIONAL PRONOUNS DAY

Promotes the use of transgender and gender non-conforming language.

NOVEMBER

ALL MONTH

TRANS AWARENESS MONTH

Celebrates trans and gender nonconforming people and includes activities to increase awareness and activism for these communities.

DATE TBD

SOLIDARITY WEEK

Sponsored by GLEN. Students are pressured to affirm LGBTQ ideology and considered 'haters' or 'bigots' for holding a dissenting view. Traditionally this week is held in November.

NOV 13 - 19

TRANSGENDER AWARENESS WEEK

Promotes the visibility of transgender and gender non-conforming individuals and legitimizes transgender ideology.

NOV 20

TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE

Honors transgender victims of violence. Violence is always wrong, but this day promotes harmful transgender ideology and is emotionally manipulative.

DECEMBER

DEC 8

PANSEXUAL PRIDE DAY

Celebrates people who are sexually attracted to males and females, and all gender identities.

FEBRUARY

DATE TBD

SCHOOLS NATIONAL DAY OF READING

Books that promote transgender ideology are read to children. The date for 2024 is TBD.

FEB 19-25

<u>AROMANTIC</u>

AWARENESS WEEK

Is a week that focuses on people who do not experience romantic attraction, are repulsed by romance, or are not interested in romantic relationships.

MARCH

MARCH 31

INTERNATIONAL TRANSGENDER DAY OF VISIBILITY

Celebrates and promotes transgender ideology.

APRIL

APRIL 14

DAY OF SILENCE

Honors and promotes LGBTQ ideology. When observed in schools, students feel pressured to participate.

APRIL 26

LESBIAN DAY OF VISIBILITY

Honors and promotes lesbianism.

MAY

MAY 17

OF HOMOPHOBIA, TRANSPHOBIA, AND BIPHOBIA

Honors and promotes LGBTQ ideology. Any student who objects to the ideology can be considered "phobic."

MAY 24

PANSEXUAL VISIBILITY DAY

Celebrates and recognizes those who identify as pansexual.

JUNE

ALL MONTH

PRIDE MONTH

Honors and promotes LGBTQ ideology. Schools may host Pride parades, read LGBTQ-themed books, host a Pride assembly, etc.

*The dates for these observances do not fall during the school week. Parents should still be aware of them as they may be observed on a different day.
